1)	I must register as a Certified User of the data base.		
2)	I may use the data base exclusively to recruit participants for studies run under the auspices of the Max Planck Institute for Psycholinguistics. I may NOT use it for any other purposes (e.g., for a study run under the auspices of another institution or for commercial purposes).		
3)	In order to prevent any unauthorised use of the data base (e.g. after a theft or loss of electronic equipment) I must not copy any parts of the data base onto external data storage media (memory sticks, hard drives).		
4)	The data base may be printed for immediate use only. If I leave the room, I must store the list in a locked cupboard. Printouts must be destroyed promptly after using a shredder.		
5)	I may only use printouts from the data base on the premises of the Institute. In other words, I am not allowed to take printouts home.		
6)	I will always login to the data base through an MPI server. In other words, on a computer on the premises of the Institute, or through a remote desktop connection.
