# Specials with Bruner books

Jerome Bruner's books have dedications are other material attached to them, we also added comments in the metadata. At the moment only (or better) visible with our 'old' catalog

- <u>footnotes</u>: In the footnote field we list the presence of text, comments on the sideline or on post-its, dogears, underlines, ...
  - if the comments are throughout the book, the footnote says: 'with comments'
  - if the comments are only in one chapter the footnote says 'comments in chapter ..' or 'with comments on pages 3-12'
- special <u>additional content</u>: additional content we scan and attach the scan to the book description. The scans are called note.
  - dedications
  - correspondence
  - business cards
  - recommendation
  - other : (boarding cards, invoices, shopping lists, ...)



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
# Open Access journal articles at MPI Nijmegen 2016-2022

CHECK: does the journal has (Gold or Hybrid) Open Access options?

Before submitting to a journal:

- Check your funders requirements (if applicable)
- think about uploading your manuscript to a preprint server

- Check if MPG offers APC funding -> <u>https://oapublishing.mpdl.mpg.de/journals/</u> Radboud: <u>https://www.openaccess.nl/</u>)
- If yes: submit and follow instructions after acceptance!
- If not no central OA funding:
  - check if your OAAPC will be funded with your MPI department
  - If not:



• UNESCO, European Commission (Horizon Europe, and ERC) • USA: Year of Open Science • European Open Science Cloud (EOSC) • National Research Data Infrastructure (NFDI) • Future Research Data Act (Germany)

### Max Planck Position re Open Science (G6 statement on Open Science):

- Future research assessment should incentivize the provision of Open Access, FAIR data, software, tools, and active contributions to Open Science, and in this way enable the appreciation of the work involved.
- Researchers and support staff must gain the knowledge and skills required to embrace new open science practices, and new roles must be introduced in the RPOs staff.

### Abstract

nfants start learning words, the building blocks of language, at least by 6 months. To do so, they must be able to extract the phonological form of words from running speech. A rich literature has investigated this process, termed word segmentation. We addressed the fundamental question of how infants of different ages segment words from their native language using a meta-analytic approach. Based on previous popular theoretical and experimental work, we expected infants to display familiarity preferences early on, with a switch to novelty preferences as infants become more proficient at processing and segmenting native speech. We also considered the possibility that this switch may occur at different points in time as a function of infants' native language and took into account the impact of various task- and stimulus-related factors that might affect difficulty. The combined results from 168 experiments reporting on data gathered from 3774 infants revealed a persistent familiarity preference across all ages. There was no significant effect of additional factors, including native language and experiment design. Further analyses revealed no sign of selective data collection or reporting. We conclude that models of infant information processing that are frequently cited in this domain may not, in fact, apply in the case of segmenting words from native speech.


